The other women and children of the village would just watch me as I learned something that was new to me. They knew I was miles away from home, but there I was, in their river trying to wash clothes and be a part of their culture. I was rewarded with smiles and laughter. I may not have been able to dig a well, but God had other work for me to do. God can use you. Just be pliable in His hands.
