A word from Bobby

Exponential growth! We have seen our small investments of time and money grow significantly in the lives of people being touched in Central America, North America, Europe, and Africa. We have found the favor of God in our words and deeds. We have been blessed to work with some of the most loving and compassionate people on planet earth! Our clothing ministry continues to clothe the needy and provide some important jobs for people. We have shipped approximately 100,000 pounds of clothes or 4 containers of clothing to Costa Rica with a strong help from David Becker of Goodwill.

In the 2011 drought and devastation of Sub Sahara Africa, we have witnessed the co-op gardens grow. Starting from an idea to 12 women, to 35 families farming in one location. We are seeing these gardens multiply to other areas as the techniques are being taught. In two locations, we have helped with the placing and purchasing of 2 small greenhouses. These gardens are helping to eliminate hunger and malnutrition for the indigenous Maasai people and they are producing a small profit. This profit assisted in the purchasing of corn meal, sugar and other needed items for survival. Also, their children are able to go to school on a regular basis without being hungry and the school fees are paid from these small garden profits.

Water is life and we are placing more water wells in the indigenous communities of Africa. We were able to visit a few of the established water well systems and the people were happy to have fresh clean water. Their eyes were clear and a Samburu man named Samuel gave a witness that the Gospel is being preached. The water well system in memory of the late Rev. Joe Robinson is being placed in the near future. God is Good!
