Dear Bobby, Nancy, and Unto the Least of His Supporters,

Thank you for the generous gift of a medical clinic for one of our neediest villages, some of the least served people in East Africa. We are sure many or most people in Kenya have no idea that many of these villages even exist. This clinic serves a group of communities within a 200-mile circumference. The clinic is now operational and already helping to save the lives of villagers in northern Kenya.

Recently, an emergency call came in after midnight from a nearby village. Because everyone was completely exhausted from a very busy day in our ministry, I went on the call myself. Once in the village, I found a young mother having complications with childbirth and had to help deliver her breech baby in the middle of the night in a mud hut with just the firelight from small smoky embers in the "kitchen" (3 rocks and a pot).

There were no midwives around and we couldn't move her at that point, but God guided us through. After the new infant finally arrived, an elderly woman from the village took an old shoe, turned it over and cut off the umbilical cord with a razor blade on the filthy goat-poop encrusted tread, introducing the infant to all the antibodies it will need for a life-time! **See photos.

Suddenly, the new mother began hemorrhaging badly. We rushed her to the nearest medical care—the newly constructed Josena medical clinic in Nasumai, where the nurse practitioner went to work immediately. It was a very close call, but she was able to save the lives of both the mother and the newborn infant.

We are so grateful for the gift of this clinic!
