It's like having a mobile water well! These will help carry clean water to any villages wherever there is a need. This will save countless lives, especially in an emergency. We can also bring water to construction work sites such as clinics or community water tank cisterns.

Each trailer holds 5000 liters of water and will serve thousands of villagers. They will require little maintenance, yet are also a sustainability project -- they can also provide potential income through the delivery of clean water to local businesses when not being used in villages!
