This little light of mine, I'm going to let it shine! I'm so proud of our friends and partners of this ministry because our little lights are shining bright for God and His creation. Our lights are helping to disperse hardship issues among some of the world's poorest people. Our generosity is giving life and health solutions to an indigenous people and our lights are allowing the surrounding world to see hope, faith and love in action.

Our solar powered medical clinics are helping to provide streams of medical services to materialistically poor African areas. These "Tin Can Miracles" or these modern-day labors of love are not easy or inexpensive. We have completed 10 clinics and we have shipped 8.

Not only have we provided millions of dollars of much needed pharmaceutical items in each clinic, we have also provided school supplies, book bags, shoes, books, baby diapers, handmade dresses, shorts, hats, blankets and reusable menstrual pads to girls in school. These helps have come from Alabama, Georgia, South Carolina, Nebraska and Scotland.

Also, we are helping to provide solar powered water well systems, deep water pumps, water tanks, solar engineering expertise as well as complex metal roofing systems. These roofing systems provide layers of protection from the hot sun, torrential rains, water adversities and it provides shade for the medical workers and the patients. Recently, our ministry helped provide an incubator that saved a child's life.

Another area of our work is in the drought and famine areas of Northern Kenya. Our good friends, Dr. Michael Lowerikoi and Dipa, have been providing famine services and relief. One family traveled 4 miles by foot to get some corn maize and sugar for their family.

Our Christian lights are shining in the world to give God glory and to give our broken world hope that someone cares. Thank you for letting your light shine!

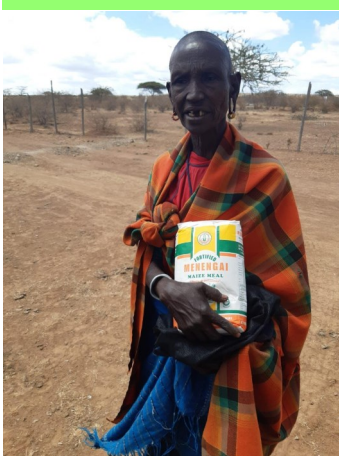
Pastor Receives Robe
