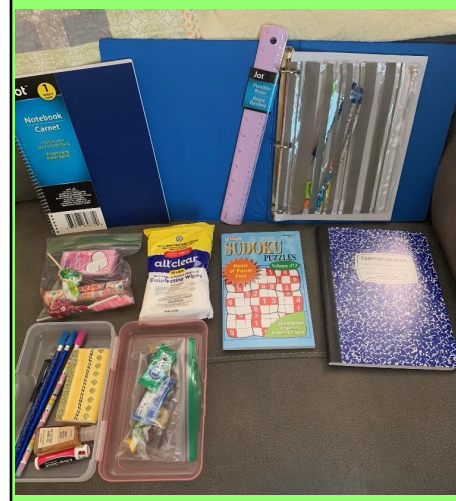
BARNABAS BAGS

We are building some Barnabas School Bags if you or your church would like to help.

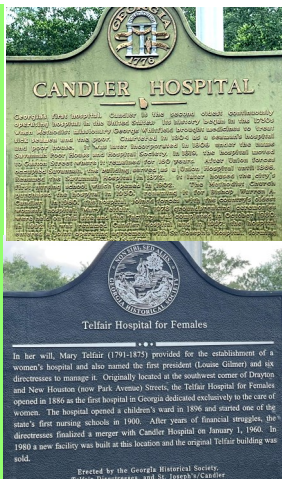
- 2 notebooks
